

Troup County Local State of Emergency Ordinance

 Response
to COVID-19

The Troup County Board of Commissioners amended the local state of emergency ordinance to include the following regulations:

- Currently in effect for 45 days or until 5/16/20, unless terminated.
- Restaurants must cease dine-in services but may offer delivery, drive-through or take-out services.
- Gyms, fitness centers, indoor amusement facilities, bowling alleys, pool halls, theaters, massage parlors, nail salons, barbershops, hair salons, tattoo parlors, etc. must close and remain closed for the duration of the emergency.

- Grocery stores, pharmacies, etc. must post signage on doors informing consumers to maintain at least 6 ft. of distance away from others.
- No public gatherings (10 or more) on any property owned or controlled by the County.
- All public and private gatherings of more than 10 people occurring outside of a household or living unit are prohibited. This does not include essential businesses.
