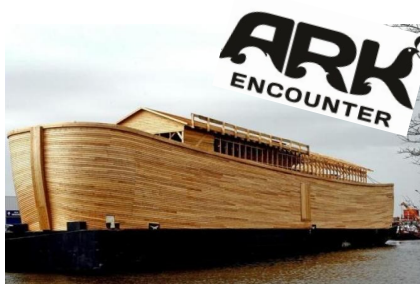

7 Days - 6 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1- A morning departure from your hometown has you heading to your overnight stop where lodging has been arranged for you this evening (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 2 - Following breakfast, check out and travel to Williamstown, KY to visit the **Ark Encounter**, a Christian evangelistic outreach intended to bring the Ark of Noah's day to life, complete with a 510-foot-long full-size ark. The Ark will equip visitors to understand the reality of the events that are recorded in the book of Genesis. Prepare to be blown away as you explore this life-sized reconstruction of Noah's Ark. Built according to the dimensions given in the Bible, the Ark Encounter contains three decks of world-class exhibits illustrating what life aboard the Ark may have been like, discussing flood geology and the subsequent ice age. Outside the Ark, you'll find **Ararat Ridge Zoo**. Visit animals from around the world like Tibetan yaks, kangaroos, and ostriches. Lunch is on your own. Later, continue traveling to Chicago ... known as the "Windy City". Chicago is one of the most exciting cities in the USA. After checking into your hotel in late afternoon, you will have time to freshen up before departing for **dinner** at one of Chicago's popular restaurants.
- Day 3 - Enjoy breakfast, then depart with your guide on a **tour of Chicago's highlights**. After the tour, stop at the historic **Navy Pier**, which features shops and eateries. This afternoon you will enjoy a relaxing 75-minute **Architectural Cruise along the Chicago River** with breathtaking views of Chicago's skyline. Chicago's architecture is known worldwide and there's nothing like seeing it from all three branches of the Chicago River. View over 40 Chicago landmarks, including the Tribune Tower, Wrigley Building, and Marina City, from hidden architectural treasures to the city's most famous landmarks. Learn how Chicago's buildings, architecture and engineering made the city famous. After the cruise, return to your hotel to freshen up before departing for a delicious **dinner** in the area.
- Day 4 - After breakfast, depart for a visit to the new **Obama Presidential Center & Museum** in Chicago's South Side. The Center aims to inspire, empower, and connect people to bring change home. A space where people of all ages and all backgrounds can join together to build a shared future. In the afternoon, visit Chicago's "**Magnificent Mile**" where you can enjoy some of the city's fabulous architecture as well as some free time for shopping and sightseeing on your own. A delicious **dinner** in Greektown will complete your day.
- Day 5 - Following breakfast, visit the **Chicago Fed's Money Museum**, followed by a visit to the **Lincoln Park Conservatory** where you will witness the spectacular displays. Later, head for Chicago's **Skydeck Observation Deck** on the 103rd floor at the Willis Tower (*formerly the Sears Tower*) from which you will enjoy spectacular, breathtaking views spanning up to four states and several interactive displays. Step outside onto the Ledge's glass balcony that extends 4 feet from the Skydeck and 1,353 feet in the air. When completed in 1973, it was the tallest building in the world; currently, it is the third tallest building in the U.S. and the Western Hemisphere, and the 23rd tallest in the world. Afterwards, head to one of the **casinos** in the Chicago area for some gambling excitement and a chance to win the jackpot. Enjoy **dinner** at one of the area's popular restaurants.
- Day 6 - Enjoy breakfast, then check out and travel to Petersburg, KY to spend the day at **The Creation Museum**. The state-of-the-art 70,000 square-foot museum brings the pages of the Bible to life, casting its characters and animals in dynamic form and placing them in familiar settings. Adam and Eve live in the Garden of Eden; children play and dinosaurs roam near Eden's Rivers, and the serpent coils cunningly in the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Majestic murals, great **masterpieces** brimming with pulsating colors and details, provide a backdrop for many of the settings. After your visit, travel to your overnight stop for lodging (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 7 - After a continental breakfast, check out and depart for home with lasting memories of Chicago.
